Key Takeaways

- New mandatory positive response rule implemented in September 2024; excavators must review electronic positive responses before digging
- NRCGA damage prevention training program seeing good participation; 151 trained in July, 73 in August, 55 in September
- Task force exploring incremental changes to short notice ticket system, starting with UI updates to discourage misuse

Alliance Representative Nominations for NRCGA Board of Directors

- Currently have two candidates for this new alliance representative position: Scott Allen and Harold Lefler
- Position bridges NRCGA board with contractor/excavator organizations like NUCA or NCA
- Nominations closed, NRCGA members will vote soon to fill position to add depth to excavator representation

NRCGA Damage Prevention Training

- Hands-on, scenario-based training covering law, best practices, ticket management
- Available in English and Spanish; free of charge
- 9 classes held in July, 7 in August, 10 in September
- Considering targeted outreach to high-damage groups like landscapers in 2025

Short Notice Ticket Task Force Update

- Not eliminating short notice tickets, but implementing incremental changes
- Updating UI to label as "non-compliant short notice" to discourage misuse
- Will monitor data for several months to assess impact before considering further changes
- Hydro-excavation companies working on process to document existing marks/responses to align with regulations

New Rulemaking on Mandatory Positive Response

- Implemented September 2024, aligns Nevada with federal PHMSA requirements
- Requires utilities to provide electronic positive response and excavators to review before digging
- PUCN to conduct field audits in 2025, initially taking educational approach

Next Steps

- Close alliance representative nominations and fill position
- Implement changes for short notice tickets in USA North's ticket system
- Continue monitoring short notice ticket usage data
- Develop educational materials on new EPR requirements for excavators
- PUCN to prepare for 2025 field audits on new rule compliance
- Explore options for improving hydro-excavation company compliance with regulations
