MEMBERSHIP

<u>MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS ROTATE BETWEEN CARSON CITY, LAS VEGAS</u>

The NRCGA Board of Directors voted to rotate 2024 meetings between Carson City and Las Vegas to include Northern Nevada members. January, May and September meetings were hosted at the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada's Carson City office. March, July and November meetings were hosted at the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada's Las Vegas office. • 1,567 EXCAVATORS, LANDSCAPERS, OTHERS TRAINED

The NRCGA's Education & Training Committee taught the fundamentals of "Call Before You Dig" best practices to 1,567 excavators, landscapers and other contractors statewide. The two-hour classes were provided in English and Spanish. The Education & Training Committee revamped their presentation to include interactive scenarios in a classroom setting, as well as an outdoor mock jobsite. • Silver Shovel Award – Southern Nevada

One hundred and fifty (150) excavators, locators and utility operators attended the NRCGA's 2024 Silver Shovel Award Ceremony and dinner on April 4 at Desert Willow Golf Course in Henderson. On August 2, the NRCGA worked with USA North 811 to sponsor an "811 Call Before You Dig Night" at the Las Vegas Ballpark. Approximately 7,316 fans attended the ball game, including 300 lucky people who were able to take advantage of the promotional tickets for \$8.11. NRCGA volunteers handed out 811-themed giveaways, including 500 cooling towels and 650 sunglasses. o <u>5th Annual Utility Locate Rodeo</u>

The NRCGA's 5th Utility Locate Rodeo took place Oct. 19 at the College of Southern Nevada, Charleston Campus. Twenty-eight locators from around the state competed for \$7,500 in prize money, all donated by sponsors. The locators competed in one of three divisions: gas, electric or telecom. Each division winner took home \$1500. COMMITTEE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

• Short Notice Tickets Task Force

Due to member concerns regarding the use of Short Notice dig ticket types, the NRCGA Board of Directors implemented this task force in 2024 with the goal of reviewing short-notice ticket policy and making recommendations to move forward. The task force established guidelines requiring short-notice 811 dig tickets to be labeled "non-compliant short notice." USA North 811 will track the impact on short-notice ticket volume. If misuse is suspected, the task force will regroup.

o Craig Rogers Celebration of Life/Craig Rogers Award

The Board of Directors voted to hold a celebration of life ceremony in January 2024 to honor Craig Rogers, a longstanding NRCGA member and PUCN employee who passed away in Oct. 2023. Approximately 150 NRCGA members and friends met to enjoy lunch and share stories about how Craig, a well-known jokester, made them laugh and positively impacted damage prevention in Nevada. The Board subsequently voted to establish a committee to explore creating an award in Craig's honor. The committee began meeting in 2024 with the goal of establishing guidelines for award candidates and expects to present the first award at Southern Nevada's Silver Shovel Award ceremony in April 2025.
