

Judge Job Description

- Attend the Judge's meeting and mandatory Competitor Meeting Saturday morning prior to Rodeo.
- Familiarize yourself with the current Rodeo Rules.
- Register as Rodeo Volunteer
- Attend breakout meeting for volunteer training

Competition Duties

- Attend mandatory Competitor Meeting and Volunteer training
- Arrive at your event site prior to the competitors
- Help breakdown event site only after division manager confirms event is complete.

An Event Judge must complete the checklist below prior to start of competition and give it to an Event Leader.

_____ Clamp records/maps to Judge's table. Do not move map or table for any reason, move the tent if it is a shade issue.

_____ Confirm there are 20 Rodeo Coins on Judge's table.

_____ Confirm there are Judges Checklists (20), Event Site Templates (20) and a clipboard from Judge's bin.

_____ Confirm there are pens and a clipboard for competitor.

_____ Confirm there are two yellow flags for boundary infractions in Judge's bin

_____ Ensure stopwatch from Judge's bin is working.

_____ Ensure Rodeo Wheel is intact and tape measure is functioning properly.

_____ Check competition site bin for back up supplies- string, knife, hammer, etc..**(If a string is broken, needs to be tightened, or any adjustments need to be made on a wheel then a member of the event site committee must be called to perform this task)**

_____ Familiarize yourself with the competitor's staging area and scorekeeper for your event

_____ Familiarize yourself with the event site boundaries (indicated by traffic cones with Rodeo Flags attached to it) Use the yellow flag to indicate a competitor has gone out of

bounds. **Make sure your flag is with you at all times. A Master Judge must be notified in case of a DQ.**

_____ Familiarize yourself with the Judge's Script for your event site.

_____ Review Competitors list for your Division. Make a note on the competitors that are employed by the same company you work for. This will allow for some advance planning for a replacement judge for that competitor (Let the Event Leader know what competitors you can not judge. The Event Leader will switch positions with the Judge when that competitor is "On Deck". This will ensure that there is no delay in competition.)
